## Scripture verses from the Warrior Series Week 2:

As the Warrior series goes into the final week, I'd like to remind you of some of the verses and points we visited last week.

### 1) Judges 6:11-16

Gideon was a survivor but he had a very poor self-image. God often speaks prophetically to our potential, even though we can't see it in ourselves at times. When fear of failure exceeds our faith we can become hesitant and fearful.

### 2) 2 Peter 1:3-10

This scripture is packed with promise and potential. God has given us ALL THINGS that pertain to life (everything we need to live our lives) and Godliness (everything we need to serve God!). Through this knowledge and experience we become partakers of the divine nature. We start to model the nature of God in our own lives, with all of the heavenly attributes that come with it.

- Our efforts are based on the sovereignty of God and the sufficiency of His provisions!
- God's grace, spiritual gifts, God-given natural abilities and talents can take you to the top. But your character is what will keep you there! (Keep you in the fight!)

Every warrior must develop a passion for the cause!

John 2:16-17—Jesus had passion for God's cause—zeal = jealous for God!

The passionate warrior has:

- Someone to protect (Neh 4:14) and
- A kingdom to advance! (Matt 11:22)
